Beloved Partners and Family of God,

The Psalmist wrote, "What shall I render to the Lord for all His benefits towards me? How can I repay Him for all His bountiful dealings?" As I sit down to write to you again this month I echo the same sentiments as the Psalmist for all the great and wonderful things the Lord has done to us this month. It's been one of the greatest month's for me and my children and to think that we have come this far fills my heart with gratitude to God because He has walked with us since the year begun. Immediately the Leigh's Blankie team left the Australian team pitched camp! I have been so blessed this year to host one team after another amidst traveling for fundraising missions. God has continued to renew my strength with every passing day and I thank God so much that by His Grace He has enabled me to come this far.

The Australian team did an amazing job with the adopt a basket program which has continued to grow in leaps and bounds. Every year our families get a basket of food for Christmas through the program at a colorful ceremony dubbed Huruma Fun day. Initially the program started with 40 baskets for our slum families and has this year grown to over 400 baskets. Parents came in huge numbers to receive their Christmas basket and we thank God for Pastor Murray and Caz Holmes lead pastors of Liquid church Australia for being a blessing to our families. We also know that the entire church, elders and friends of the church play a great role towards this program and on behalf of all our parents I extend our gratitude to them as well.



On the same month my children also had an opportunity to receive the gift of baptism. When I recently visited Australia one of the things that Pastor Murray and Caz Holmes asked to do during their mission to Huruma this year was if they could have a baptism service. When I got back home we started planning for it with the school chaplain and with the help of our pastor Jojo the service was successfully held with over 60 children baptized. It was a wonderful day and I thank God for filling the gap that was left by my late husband who used to fulfill this role.



To crown the month we also received donations from the Coca-Cola company of food stuffs, shoes and books for our children. We cannot thank them enough for their continued support over the years. As we begin the year 2016 our hearts are full as my children boast of a new pair of school shoes. What a blessing this is to us! I am reminded of a time in my life when I was struggling to put a meal on the table and in my pain I made a statement that my Kenyan people will one day feed me. I did not know that I was making a prayer and that God had heard me but looking back now and seeing all the donations that we receive every year from different organizations and individuals here in Kenya is a testimony of an answered prayer.



Our children enjoyed a whole day of fun with Coca-Cola as they danced and shared their drinks with them. We also thank God for all my other local partners and friends who have been a blessing to us this year. I may not mention all of you by name but I pray that the God who sees what is done in secret will reward you all for meeting the needs of the orphaned. Because of you my children have not lacked a meal on their table, clothing and shoes on their feet. We make mention of you in our daily prayers and we know that God shall supply all your needs as well.



We are now bracing ourselves for the special season of Christmas when we celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ. We have not stopped singing Christmas Carols in readiness for the jolly season! I am currently fulfilling my role of being a full time mother to my dear children who remain with me at the Home during this season. With only a few days to go and as the year draws to a close we cannot help but sing for joy in thankfulness to Him.

Special thanks to Cornerstone Church in Chandler AZ, who have stood with me through the straight and narrow and enabled me to give my children a Christmas gift in addition to a special meal.

Dear Friends,

Oh goodness, where to begin? :) God is so good.

On November 8th our Leigh's Blankie Transition Team left for Huruma Children's Home in Ngong Hills, Kenya to equip 23 young adults to start life on their own. With the help of many generous families and the support of Huruma we supplied each student with a "Housing Kit" that included all the basic necessities for them to be independent. We spent our first week teaching them life skills like budgeting, negotiating in the

market, maintaining healthy lifestyles and relationships and the importance of being in God's word each day. They also took a spiritual gifts class and determined the special gifts God has blessed them with. Each morning they received a yummy breakfast as we did devotions together. At the end of the week, it was move day. Can you imagine moving 23 orphans into tiny homes in a 3rd world country? Emotions flood my mind just as I think of that day. After making their beds, hanging their curtains and making their house a home, their mother (Mama Zipporah) sat with them on their beds. She told us their stories in detail on how they came to live with her at Huruma.

Many of the students cried as she spoke of their parents who had died of HIV or were too ill to care for him or had ultimately abandoned them. Then Mama would cry over each of them as she poured her heart out to God in prayer, asking for His protection and thanking Him for His provision. Our lives will be forever changed because of this experience. What a privilege for our team to be a part of this important season of their lives. And what a privilege to do God's work. We were also able to see the group that transitioned out of the orphanage last year. The majority of them have held their employment at Huruma and have been coming to church each week over the past year. Mama Z is so proud of them and so are we!! She has communicated many times her gratefulness to God for giving us the vision of the Transition Project and how it has impacted the lives of her children in such a positive way. Praise God!

I want to personally thank you all again for your prayers, support and encouragement for the projects God has called us to at Huruma. The next step will be for us to roof the system by covering it with a shade net to reduce evaporation in January when it's usually dry and scorching hot. As usual we are grateful to our funding partners Feeding Mouths; Filling Minds for contributing towards this noble and transformational course.
