- ❖ 2013 results were not submitted for analysis, therefore we were not ranked.
- ❖ 2014 we were ranked position 50 out of 80 schools.
- ❖ 2015 our position has gone up significantly from last year with a ranking of 27 out of 80 schools. We are above the county average which is promising. Our goal this year for the final exams is 4.50 C- which we feel is achievable.
- ❖ Our top students in 2015 mock exams are:
  - #1 - Nehemiah Shikati who was ranked position 21 out of 4030 students.
  - #2 - Andrew Kamau who was ranked position 119 out of 4030 students.
  - #3 - Mary Njambi who was ranked position 242 out of 4030 students.
